BACKGROUND

Earlier this year, the Adelaide Area Neighbourhood Watch tried to renew. A meeting was called and held in the downstairs hall. Other than the organizers and the Mayor, no one else attended. On June 21, 2017, the Metcalfe Neighbourhood Watch and the Adelaide Area Neighbourhood Watch held a joint meeting. A copy of the minutes from the meeting is attached.

ANALYSIS

There is little interest in continuing with the committees. Both groups have decided to disband. Leftover funds from each group were submitted to the Township, along with records, supplies and some signs. The organizers wished that the Township use the funds to maintain the existing Neighbourhood Watch signs and purchase new signs as required.
